Founded in 1970, the UK branch of the Gay Liberation Front (GLF) was formed by gay students attending the London School of Economics. Passionately advocating for changes in society, the GLF's list of demands include the end of gender and sexuality-based discrimination, and freedom of LGBTQ+ expression. As well as demonstrating for LGBTQ+ rights, the GLF went on to establish London's first Pride march in July 1972. The surviving members continue to campaign for the freedom and power of all oppressed people.
